Description	Assistance from the Intensive Housing Management Team is available for tenants aged 16 or over who are experiencing domestic abuse in any capacity. DA related support must be consented to by the Tenant. The team's case work involves Safety Planning, referrals to other agencies, risk assessment through a DASH form and where necessary, cases are heard at MARAC to task all involved agencies with actions to prioritise the safety of the case. The team can work towards rehousing within Derby or enable tenants to approach other Local Authorities, raise repairs and work alongside the Crime Prevention Team to implement safety measures within the property. The team deal with tenancy related issues caused by domestic abuse and work to build rapport and trust with people at this vulnerable time in their lives.
