Male Survivors



- One in five/six men will experience domestic abuse at some point in their lifetime.
- 49% of men don't tell anyone about their experiences of domestic abuse.
- 11% of male survivors consider suicide.
- Very few refuges in UK for men.



Male Refuge

- The Elm Foundation has one of the only male only refuges in the local area.
- All referrals for refuge come in via the helpline.
- Agency checks are done by refuge staff.
- Screening tool.



The Harmony Project

- Young women aged 16-24 and their children.
- Relationship abuse, sexual exploitation, forced marriage.
- Specialist refuge & targeted support.
- Manage risk, support recovery, build resilience.
